NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO RECEIVE PROTESTS

Tracy Village Reorganization to the City of Tracy (LAFC 24-19)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Joaquin Local Agency Formation Commission will hold a public hearing to receive protests against the proposed Tracy Village Reorganization to the City of Tracy. The Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) approved the annexation of 180 acres to the City of Tracy with concurrent detachments from Tracy Rural Fire District and the San Joaquin County Resource Conservation District on October 10, 2019. The purpose of the annexation is for the development of 590 age-restricted single-family homes. The adjacent 42 lots consisting of existing rural residential uses and portions of Corral Hollow and Valpico Roads are included in this proposed annexation.

The hearing will be held on Thursday, November 14, 2019 at 9:30 a.m. at Tracy City Hall, Room 203, 333 Civic Center Drive, Tracy.


Written protests against this proposal may be filed by registered voters or property owners owning land within the annexation boundary. Protests may either be mailed to San Joaquin LAFCo, 509 W. Weber Avenue, Suite 420, Stockton, CA 95203 or delivered to the Executive Officer of San Joaquin LAFCo at the protest hearing. Each protest must state whether it is made by a property owner or a registered voter and must include your name, address, address of land owned within the affected area if different from your residence or Assessor's Parcel Number. Include your signature, and the date the signature was signed to the protest. All signatures without a date or bearing a date prior to the date of publication of this notice, or submitted after the conclusion of the hearing, will be disregarded for purposes of ascertaining the value of written protests.

You may also use the protest form that is available on the San Joaquin LAFCO website at: www.sjgov.org/commission/lafco. If you are not opposed to the proposed Tracy Village annexation, you need not take any action.

At the conclusion of the Protest Hearing, each protest will be counted separately. The results of protests received will be determined within 30 days following the hearing in accordance with California Government Code §57075 and 57078.
