NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING Archtown Reorganization to the City of Stockton (LAFC 09-20)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Thursday, March 11, 2021, at 9:00 A.M. the San Joaquin Local Agency Formation Commission will hold a telephonic public hearing to consider the Archtown Reorganization to the City of Stockton. In accordance with the Governor's Executive Order N33-20, LAFCo has arranged for of the public to observe and address the meeting telephonically. The City of Stockton has submitted an application to annex 79.14 acres to the City of Stockton consisting of four parcels and a portion of Newcastle Road right-of-way. The annexation area is located at the southwestern corner of the intersection of Arch Road and Newcastle Road, adjacent to the city limits. The reorganization includes detachments from Montezuma Fire Protection District, Central San Joaquin Water Conservation District, and the San Joaquin County Resource Conservation District. The City proposes development of the site into industrial uses.

Pursuant to Section 56663 of the California Government Code, if no written objection is received from landowners within the annexation area before the conclusion of the Commission proceedings on the proposal, the Commission intends to waive the protest proceedings. There is potential for the extension or continuation of any previously authorized charge, fee, assessment, or tax by a local agency in the affected territory.
